

## 10 Steps to Review in Each Re-report

### Step 1: Why they came in

Possibly you could ask them what they remember to be their initial reason they came to your practice...

### Step 2: What was wrong and why

Failure to learn... (to care for their spine from birth...)

Compounded with doctors who never told them they needed to look to the cause of the symptoms

### Step 3: How present spinal condition relates to their history

Nerve chart and how everything in your body is controlled by your nervous system

### Step 4: What was your original recommendation

Not 9 months or 12 months- BUT to care for their spine in the way you outline FOR THE REST OF THEIR LIFE!!!

The start of this was the initial 9 months....

### Step 5: Reminder of lifetime care

Ask them to state why is taking care of their nervous system EVERYTHING to them? To be able to be a better mom? (for example)

### Step 6: Improvements

NO end to the benefits to your body while you are under regular chiropractic care (where else do you get those returns?)

### Step 7: What will never improve

After phase 1 you can never go back to normal

### Step 8: Strengths of their engagement

Your education is more important than your adjustments- educating you on THINKING differently

### Step 9: Weakness of engagement

What has been missed- adjustments, frequency and intensity, SWS

You need the tools to live differently

### Step 10: What lies ahead

This will take the rest of your life

More than 40% of your recovery is what you do outside the practice
